And also the false beliefs of the people.

Show on an Island. In the beginning on that land there was nobody but after some time people come and occupied the land and became rich and they put sign boards no entry and the people who came approached to had no chance of entering into the land because the rich covered themselves with a fence and sign boards no entry. Here also we see rich are crying when poor people are suffering because of starvation sell clothing and so on. Here rich people are best bothered about the poor people. What do you learn from the skit on ~~poor~~ consciousness and different approaches and development?

In this skit we see that all are approaching the poor man with their own methods, solutions.

Here we have the approach of the worker with Parasol. First approaches the worker with a Rasay. The scientist approaches him with seed. The doctor approaches him with injection.

But now I understand that it is ~~you do~~ ^{who (Doctors)} mainly do this work. Through this cause I learned a lot about myself and the people outside. And also this cause helped me to go ^{back} to myself and see what is my role in this situation. Especially slide shows gives me a deep understanding of the people who live in slums.

1. Community is a group of people living together under one leader or the same rule followed by everybody.

Health is a state of well-being (Physical, Mental, Social, spiritual) and not absence of disease or infirmity. Health is doing the things in correct time and in correct way.

Development concept is full-growth state of Economic, political, social, cultural and Religious. They are inter-connected with each other.

2. Community health is a well-being of each individuals ~~and~~ ~~well-being~~ ~~of~~ ~~society~~ in a society. Each one is responsible for his own and the community's health. This is possible only by keeping neat and clean the surroundings, drinking good water, & Educating the people on health. and so on.

3. Healing is possible only the person who wants to be healed. Then the healer worker may be successful. we see in the New Testament Jesus was going across to the countries and he was curing the sick, helping lame, fewer and driving out the demons and so on. this was possible because of the sick people. they were eager to be healed. They were ready to listen to the words of Christ. And also from the various Gospel quotations we understand the people used to requesting & π (Mark 1: 3-11, Matt 20: 24-34, Matt 15: 21-28). After healing Jesus has used to say "Go in peace." "Faith has made you well" and so on. Healing the miracle started first in the Catholic church.

It is not necessary all the sickness must be cured but accepting and bearing with patience is necessary. By experiencing the sickness we become holiness and experience the will of God.

4. The community constituted on Economic, political, social, Cultural and on Religious set up.

In the Economic System we see the Rich and Poor. This is based on one's own profession or income. and also the traditional land lords and slaves systems.

Political leaders come from the Top class of the people. They have not experienced the poor situation but they make rule and Regulations based on their own way of life.

5. Ramaccas story: From the various group discussions the important person for the Ramaccas son's death was the Government. a. Ignorance of the parents. b. Doctor I. c. Doctor II and the watchman and the Master.

There was no enough facilities to take the child to hospital. First of all there was no good road and transport and good admirable doctor or someone in her village. After reaching the town she was not knowing the time to go to hospital. Then no enough money to buy the medicines which was described by the Doctor.

Therefore the care was by doctor son's death in the Government. Of course the Government consists on so many set up such as Social, political, Economic and Religious set up.

2. The Story of Island: From this story I understand that the people who are powerful entered the Island and they occupied many places and they chased away the others people who were living in the island. This is the mistake of the people who came later to the island and they made fence and did not allow others to enter inside. After that they don't bother about outsiders. There was also so many helping hands and plans but they were not helping in a proper way which can be useful for the poor people.

6. From the Skit I learned from the skit that the man who was tied with the robe had received the important ~~sensations~~ necessary at the last moment. First, one Poojari comes first and he gives Prasadam. Second one priest comes and gives the Rosary. Thirdly one health worker or Doctor comes and gives the list of medicines. Fourthly one man comes and gives little fruit and goes away. At last one man comes and removes the robe and he gives the knife to that person to cut the robe and come away from the tidings. This something is happening in our country esp. people ~~are~~ are suffering from various reasons. in the same time so many plans and ideas are going on for the people. These things are necessary but these helps in what way? People receive little and last moment. So as a Community health worker I should know what is necessary and first to the people. For that I have to work.

Community, Health and Development

Roll No. 99

1. a) Community is a place where we live, where we belong, the place where somebody cares about us. In the most basic sense, community is a group of individuals with shared needs and aims.
- b) Health is a state of physical, mental, social well-being and not absence of disease or infirmity. It is a dynamic process and therefore we can't say that one is perfectly healthy.
- c) Throughout the history, all human populations have lived with the threat of disease and sickness. Though every society devised its own ways of dealing with this reality, it was only in the last two centuries that human beings could entertain visions of a disease free existence. The development and growth of modern medicine gave society potent tools to actively intervene in the disease process and it seemed just a matter of time before suffering and pain could be vanished from human consciousness for ever.
2. Health is often spoken of both in individual level and in community level. It is necessary to be healthy as an individual as well as as a community. For example, bringing a village into the awareness of health, and back to the diseases and its causes can bring development in the community. By organizing programmes on community health we can attract people and basic things concerning health, could be explained to them.
3. Bible uses the word 'healing' which means the ultimate healing and not curing or treating which can only mean recovery from certain levels of life. Curing can mean only bodily recovery from sickness and treatment is more connected with hospital and medicine. But healing touches all aspects of one's life. After healing Jesus says: 'go in peace', 'sin no more', 'your sins are forgiven' or 'your faith has made you well'. It shows that he gave more importance to the spiritual aspect of one's life.
4. The main systems that constitute a community are

social, economical, political and cultural. Ministry, transportation, communication, education, government, religion etc. play their role in constituting a community.

5. All these systems are interconnected. Our society is not a problem free community.

Social system: In our country it is a big problem. People fight so that their religion or beliefs may become the dominating one in the society. Instead of being a uniting force it brings out disparity.

Economical system: This is the basis of the rest of the systems. It is a dividing fact; people are divided according to the wealth they possess and at the same time poor are neglected.

Political: Instead of doing good and serving people the political parties have turned to be selfish that they look forward power, prestige and prosperity which will help them to hold their chairs firm.

Cultural: Different cultures are meant to be enriching our life through various ways. But they have now become a business because they are made use for accumulating money-money oriented.

6. Whoever came to the person gave him what they had and not what he was in need. Not knowing the miserable condition in which he lived, the people who approached him tried to solve his problem in their own way that was not applicable to him.

7. The monsoon's game depicts the real life of a village where many problems exist. First of all people are divided according to the caste, creed, possession and social status etc. Each group keep on thinking on their own welfare. The rich do not pay any attention to the betterment of the poor.

The developmental programmes or aids from the government do not reach to the poor.

8. A community animal finds himself among the people at their service. He is not a 'giver', that is, he doesn't try

to solve the problems by just giving something that is momentary, but he is a 'builder' of the community. He brings the awareness of the problems that they face to their minds, show the way to get rid of them and brings an over-all development.

9. As a E.S.T. Brother as I feel that I too must follow the methods of a community animator. I have to come down to the concrete situation of the people, make them aware of their problem, give them guidelines and show them the way how they can come out their problems by themselves. I will also follow the principle that turning the tap off is better than mopping the floor.
10. I really appreciate your way of teaching that we are given feel good participation in the class and you make us fully involved at this time. Since community, health and development cover all aspects of our life these classes are very useful for our apostolate.

1) Community is made up of many people who share similar customs and ways of looking at life and thinks of belonging to their community, which is the part of other larger community. It is defined in particular space. It has its laws, common language and problems.

Health as a whole includes physical, mental and social health. Body should work together to give physical health, mind must act normally to give you mental health, you must enjoy with being with other people Social Health. These are the three things that we need to promote in a group which is C.I.D.

(1) Community is a group of people having diverse feelings and unique ideas live for a particular purpose with mutual understanding and love. A healthy community also has the qualities of understanding, acceptance and brotherly love and the mentality of sharing and having a time-table in common. The idea of Unity in diversity is found in a healthy community.

Health: It is a state of physical, mental and social well-being. Doesn't mean; having no sickness at all.

Development: - It is a state shows all round growth of a person, place or a thing.

In Choman's story too we find the problem of Rich and Poor. Social and cultural problems as the chief cause of all other happenings.

6. Skit called consciousness and different approaches to development has contributed to a young man very much good for his life. Some body at last made him aware of the situation in which he was living and helped him to come out of that while others were behind him with many more burdens.

7. From the game called "Monsoon" I came to understand how peaceful I am here without any worries and problems. It is very difficult for a poor man to live in a village. Because there are many problems which he has to face. Rich are becoming richer and richer but the poor are becoming poorer and poorer.

7.8. The vast majority of Indian masses are struggling with their problems - the problems derived from the existing Socio-Economic Systems. Government and other agencies are trying to help them, but ordinary people are too enslaved to be liberated by their remedies. Most of them, except the animator symbolic figure of an ideal community health worker fail to realize the basic problems. They misunderstand symptoms as disease. Their welfare approaches are not helping the victim. At last the critical analyzer of animator etc. worker finds out the social systems as a real problems and provides a solution accordingly. At this rate the sufferer makes use of the clause and liberate himself from the bondage. His sketch invites us, would be community health workers, to deal the social problems, not in a superficial manner, but in the grass root level. The total liberation is our aim.

- I What are you learned about the meaning of healing and holiness?
The word 'healing' shows all the dimensions of a person. It has got deeper meaning than curing. Eg: for healing, Jesus uses some words, your sins are forgiven. Whereas 'holiness' signifies "Separateness" from the ~~messy~~ ^{messy} non-holy or profane. What is 'clean' or 'pure' also related to 'holy'. The profoundest sense of holiness is that proper to God.
- II What are the systems that constituted Community? Economic, Social, Political and Cultural, are the systems that constituted Community.
- III From the various slide shows and key studies, write a few notes about each systems?
- Economic, Social, political and Cultural systems are linked to each system. No system lies in isolation. So let us reflect on these all systems. In short, economic system is the basis of the rest of the systems or problems. When we look at our population, 70% people are living in lower class millions of people are subjected to malnutrition. The ever increasing gap between the rich and the poor. The top 10% of the population they get 1/3 of the total national income, they own 60% of the cultivated land, they possess 57% of the country's industrial wealth. 80% of the personnel IAS, IPS, IFS come from the top 10% of the population whereas the 70% population, they are largely illiterate. Political power lies in the top. Their aim is not promoting the low cast. They promote merely all over politicians and they control the political parties, but low cast. They are manipulated by political parties.

The Constitution of India Article 46 assured the Scheduled castes Social Justice and protection against all forms of exploitation and untouchability was made an offence by Article 17. Fifteen percent of the jobs was reserved for the Scheduled castes. And parliament appointed a Commission to report every year on the progress that the backward classes made in social economic, educational and other fields. But things ~~not~~ have not changed. Their discrimination and disability continue to this day. The Scheduled castes occupy the lowest rung of the ladder of progress. Education has failed to break the caste barriers and discrimination persists in all spheres of life. They are called different names. In Government parlance they are Scheduled Caste members, in upper society they are Andras, in Sophisticated talk they are Harijans. But ~~God~~^{also} they are created by God, in His own image. But in actuality they continue to remain outside.

Discrimination is the badge of this country. Deprived of Economic opportunities they continue to be socially, politically and culturally kept back world. Denied access to religious scriptures and debarred from entering places of worship, they continue to be ignorant of the basic tenets of equality contained in their religions and in their ignorance become victims of those who would twist religion to their own convenience. However, inspite of the influence of education and vigorous westernisation, the average Indian has not come out of the Cocoon of his narrow caste mentality. I would say ~~at~~ unless we try to make up this economic system, truly our Indian will more worse than this.

To What did you learn ~~from~~ about a from the Skit on consciousness and different approaches to development?

From this Skit I could learn that, man today is tied with Economy Systems and restrictions. The solution what we can give that, we must teach people how to get rid of these sophisticated situations. Here, the animator showing the way but ~~the~~ the man himself is escaping from it.

Development It is a remarkable changes and happenings that occurs in a special period of time in all the aspect. Especially in human life, it can be of the 4 aspects. Physical, economical, spiritual and political.

- What do you understand by the term community health.

Community health is a broad term that includes all aspects of public health and social services within a community.

- What do you understand by the term community development.

A term is used to describe a process of social action in which the people the community organize themselves for planning and action: define their common and individual needs and problems and solve them; execute these plans with a maximum of reliance upon community resources and supplement these resources when necessary with services and material from Governmental and non-governmental agencies outside the community. (International Co-operation Administration C.I.D. Review Decem. 1956).

The word used by term healing has a vast meaning that is. while development of the persons. not only of physical but also mental, psychological aspects of one's life. All these systems are interlinked.

— What did you learn from the sketch on consciousness and different approaches to development?

First of all it was not a real approach to a development; all those who came across this village did not study the actual happenings. Yet at their arrival (Doctor Development worker, religious leaders scientist etc etc) superficially they come to see the situation or the real life of the ordinary people. Still they were not ready to elevate them from their misery. but gives a little bit immediate help or advice and goes away and never comes back and sees them. Among them some were bounded by the rules and laws of the country, others ignorant of the very life of the people. As well as people were not educated. They tried to modernized the village not help them to come out of their own classes and difficulties such as poverty, Uneducation, sickness, malnutrition bounded labour etc.

— What did you learn about the village life from the monsoon gathering?

It was of a single village consist of may classes and formed different communities. Such as. 1- Upper class families communities, 2 middle class communities, 3 lower class families or communities, and 4 backward communities. Among these the upper and the middle class families possessed a good amount of lands and they did their education. But the lower and the backward did not have the facilities. The rich became richer and the poor become poorer. During this period there came a few ^{development worker} people such as money lender, a social worker, Bank officers etc. yet they were also favoured the rich people, not the poor. But the development worker did not have a good will to visit the backward and the lower class communities. As a whole there were no co-operation in the village upper class consulted with the same class. but the lower class never dared to consult with the upper class. lower classes were maltreated by the upper classes and in the lower class communities we found more economical problems, sickness, malnutrition death etc.

— In your opinion what is the role of a community Animator?

According to me the community Animator has the duty to analyze the existing system and study the whole life situations of the people within a few days. Organize the people into one flock, educate them, make them

3 aware of their own rights and help them to find total freedom from injustice slavery, poverty, equality etc. Above all it leads them and make them leaders for the future. make an understanding among them that they all are equally important.

- I (a) According to my understanding a community is a social unit where in the members are permanently bound together by love and responsibility and have a common purpose or view. It can be a family, society, charitable society, religious community, political community or a village community. It is a group of different people of same idea, beliefs, culture and economic aspects but united for a common purpose.

(b) Health

Health means more than not being sick. It gives us a feeling of good spirit. When we are healthy we feel happier and do better work. Health as a whole includes physical, mental, social and (religious) health. The parts of our body must work together properly to give us good ~~health~~ physical health. Our mind must act properly to give us good mental health. We must enjoy being with other people and they also must enjoy being with us for social health. And also we must experience divine presence in our life to enjoy the religious or spiritual health.

(c) Development.

Development means a process of growth in ~~economic~~, ~~social~~ social, cultural and spiritual aspects.

- (2) Community health means the condition the economic, social, cultural and spiritual conditions of the community. If the community is well set up, all people are able to see their day to day needs; the people are educated; the people are ~~not~~ physically alright and

economically and socially balanced we can say that community is healthy. And also there must be love, responsibility and openness ~~for~~ to build a healthy community.

4 Economic, political, social and religious systems constitute a community. All systems are inter-connected.

5 Economic Systems:

Economic system is the basis of all other systems.

In the community there are rich and poor; land lords and land less. The poor people always have to depend on the rich and they ~~are~~ are exploited by the rich. The rich possess ~~most~~ of the good amount of the land and income. The poor people have to manage with their little land and ~~work~~ very hard wages. Though our country possess a lot of wealth it doesn't reaches to everybody. Since they are poor they are not able to get proper education and other facilities like hospitals or other public institutions. The rich become more rich and the poor become poorer.

Political Systems:

The rich have power and influence. Actually they are the people who control the community. They possess authority over the community because of their power and economic conditions. All the decisions are made by the rich people. They are the people who always come into the leadership. They enjoyed all the privileges. Whereas the poor people have no sound in the community. They have to follow the decisions by the rich. There is no chance ~~for~~ for the poor to come out from their low life conditions. Always the rich ~~do~~ try to oppress others.

And the poor people thought that it is their lot.

Social systems

The social systems mainly depends on education and cast systems.

Only the rich people can afford education. The poor children are not able to go to school because of their poverty and their life situations. They will have to go for work to help their parents. And moreover they have no proper schools and if there are schools there won't be enough teachers. So the poor people always remain ignorant. And the rich do not allow them to be educated because they know if the people are educated they will question the injustice done to them. And another fact is that even if they study they don't get a job. So the education doesn't comply with the life.

Caste is other social evil. It is the fundamental and unique social institution of India. Caste system was based on education, job or income. But cast system unfortunately became by birth. The low cast people were always looked down. They have no rights in the community. They have to work always under the landlords like slaves and are being oppressed.

Religious systems

Religious system consists in worship; structures and festivals and beliefs. We can see that the people are guided by some superstitions and myths. For the rich people their richness becomes a means to cover the injustice that they do. After doing many crimes they go to the temple or church and give big donations to compensate their mistakes. And they feel that their sins are washed out. They are also able to put pressure on the religious authorities. The religious practices and festivals become

licence for them to do wrong. Again in the religious systems etc. we can find a kind of division like priests (Pujau) and ordinary people. The priests are often considered rich and pampered.

6 I understand that development consist not only in one aspects but other factors also like economic, social and religious etc. We cannot satisfy a person by giving him some aids always. And if we give them some help in means of money or other material helps they always will depend on us. They will not make any efforts to grow themselves. So it is advisable to make a man conscious about his life situations and help him to develop himself. Any how to grow himself he must be freed from all the economic, political social and religious systems. (It means the ^{side of the} bad systems). And to free himself he requires all these helps. certain extend we must be able to see at to it also.

7 From the monsoon game I understand the differences between the rich and the poor. A man's personality is depends on money and power and cast or religions. Though the government provides some helps and plans it is fact doesn't help the poor but only rich. ~~Because~~ The poor (low cast) will ^{know} about it only very late because they will not have any road facilities or other communication media. Then they will have to go through so many processes to get this helps or loans. And if they get it they will have to ~~spend~~ spend a good amount as bribes and other expenses. So very often the loans or other helps will not help the poor. Since they possess a little land always the poor will have to depend on the wealthier and their little cultivation. If the harvest is bad they will have to suffer. They will ~~have~~ be malnourished

and thus become sick. At the same time they will have to meet other expenses also.

But the rich possess more land and they have enough and more income. But they are not willing to share it with the poor. They are able to make use of the loans and helps from the government. And thus their productions every year go higher.

And very often most of the development workers will be other people. And they will be able to get the help of the authority also. Again we see that there is no proper communication and collaboration between the rich and the poor.

- According to me the role of the community animator is to help the people to understand what they are, what are their rights and what is their life situation. Help them to grow and develop and also help them to make some decisions. He is an instrumental cause. His duty is to make an answer to the people. He must go deep into the life of the people and live like one among them.
- From the community health development class, as a Franciscan missionary brother I understand the next areas of responsibility and work to be done. I am not only called to preach Jesus but to show or practice Jesus. And I am not only called for myself but for others too. I must be an ~~instrument~~ instrument to build up the community. My work is not to help the people by remaining as a separate person from the community and giving the some material help. But by being with them help them to grow themselves. I must be ~~available~~ available to them and go to them instead of they come in search of me. And also first of all I must first help my community to which

I belong, to develop.

According to me the classes method of the teaching is good. The method of explorations very appreciable. We are also able to express our ideas. Since I am a missionary brother I will have to live in different communities. So I gained much knowledge about the communities and systems, and the method of approaching the people and the life style of the people. It is good to give a good note of the class. Since we ~~have~~ ~~do~~ don't take classes continuously there is no continuation. So if we get a systematic note it will be very helpful. There is nothing to write more. When the classes get over we can give * good comments and ~~suggestions~~ suggestions.

(2.) Healing means the healing of a person in his physical, psychological and spiritual aspects. It is not enough to cure a person from his physical sickness alone. It doesn't help him much. When a person is healthy he is happier and cheerful. So the healing is ~~not~~ ~~only~~ ~~physical~~ ~~it's~~ ~~whole~~ freeing from all his problems. Then he will feel better. We see in the miracles of Jesus that he did not heal a person only physically but he healed the whole person.

Community :-

- (1) Group of people usually living in the same area, who are bound together by similar customs, beliefs and outlook - group of people living together for the same purpose - with mutual understanding and sharing accept and respect each other under the leadership of a common leader. joys and sufferings, agreements and disagreements are the part of the community but love unites them. community seeks harmony and brotherhood. All are not equal but limited. they organize themselves and liberate themselves.

Health :-

It is a state of physical, mental, spiritual and social well-being. In our common understanding health is the condition of being well or not sick - freedom from illness of any kind. Health, Rest sleep, exercise and cleanliness are important to one's health.

Development:

Development is the process of developing or growth. For example - development in economy - development in growth - development of plans and ideas. Here development we take it as going to the people - to go deeper into the problems and difficulties and problems they faces. What are the hindrances ~~that~~ to growth - is short - to know the real situation and find out and work out for improving the situation. We should be able to prevent - than cure. We should make the people aware of their problems and situations and give them advices and correct informations - tell them what is the solution and what is to be done for the good betterment.

- (2) Community health means not built a hospital or dispensary to treat for the sickness - but to visit the villages and distribute medicines but to be one with the community. to get to know each other - to have dialogue with each other and to come to know the real problems and difficulties that overcome the difficulties and think together how can we improve the present situation. Whatever improvement we make it should be profitable to all.

- (3) According to the present understanding healing means - treat for sickness and cure it. but we forget to find out the cause for the sickness and treat it. The best thing is - find out the cause of the sickness and treat for it. then we can stop the sickness forever. other wise we will be ~~turners~~ - floor mops - instead of Tap turners.

- (4) The authorities or social workers or even the religious people they are not really much concerned about the difficultip of the people. From that I understand that nobody helps the poor man to get out of his bondage except himself - All the others were providing him fish - but the last man taught

taught him to catch fish.

(7)

The villagers life is depend on the monsoon - also housework facilities they have got - and the much land they got to cultivate. Those who will have better facilities they will improve always - if the ~~more~~ monsoon fails also they can pump water for their cultivation. But a poor man - who have no facilities such as starve - starvation causes many sicknesses - and finally death.

(8)

The role of a community animator is the same community there are people with varied opinions and suggestions like each other - talk each other meet each other - So the animator has to go to people many times to talk them to help them to believe from their intentions. But today what the animators are doing - if we think really we can find out the cause for their interest and enthusiasm for their work - mostly they are working for their selfish motives - when they get money - so their work regularly. Catachists also are not much different from them.

(9)

The system that constitute a community are - Social system, economical system, political system etc and varna system and culture.

(5) Economic system is the basis for the rest of the system. Economic system is coming according to the wealth, property, and power according to the wealth the community is divided - the land lord can hire any number of landless workers to work their field - rich become more rich but the poor will remain poor. another system is varna system - it is divided according to the work. Brahmins, kshatriyas, vaishyas and sudras - Among the sudras one the lowest cast - they have to do all the menial works. They are separated from the other groups in all the ways. Political system - All the politicians are coming from the top class or from the middle class. So it is not useful for the poor people - whatever may be the outcome of the politics it is benefited only by the rich people. The poor are forgotten always. They never come to know what is happening in the world.

(9) I understood that my future role as a community worker. From this classes we can understand that our full support should go to the poor people who are exploited and cheated in many ways because they are poor and they are ignorant. So first I will try to understand his language - without a language we cannot do anything today. Then I will go to them and will try

to know what are their problems. why they are remain poor always is what way they are cheated and exploited. what are the causes for their suffering. Mainly - why they remain poor is they are born in a poor family. Unless one works his level best he cannot improve - Why he is not trying because nobody is their to advise them. Since they are not educated - they cannot read paper or write anything so they are unable to know what is happening around them. When they go for work - they are not getting a just wage - They are not able to ask also because they do not know how much is the just wage. They are just satisfied with what they get. So I will try to educate them. When they come to knowledge they will act wisely and they will improve. So I will put pressure in the government to make facilities for their education.

(1) The classes on community health development is very interesting and useful. It gives light to the ideas that is hidden in us. Through the slide shows and discussions - we came to knowledge of many things that was ignorant to us. Though everything is happening around us - we are just not aware of it. So through this classes - we became aware of what is happening around us. One thing I found wrong is the lack of time. Especially the classes on minor ailments. When Doctor Mani took class - we had many doubts - but the lack of time didn't allow us to clarify our doubts.

(1) Community :- Commodity consists of many groups of people who have same interests and/or aims. They will be all looking at things in ~~one~~ a similar way. They will have their own rules and laws, common language and goals.

(2) Health - It is a state of physical, mental, social well-being and not the absence of any disease.

(3) Community health means total awareness among the people about the causes of sickness and its treatment. By this the most of all the people in our country can be saved from grave illnesses as well as minor. In short we can say, community health is a way of making people tap resources and not flood resources.

(4) Healing :- It is a way of making the people ~~free~~ from their sickness. It is a matter of faith. But why? Because throughout the gospel we can see whenever Jesus healed the people Jesus says, "Go in peace" or "Your faith has made you well". This is the meaning of healing.

Wholeness -

(5) Social, Economic, Cultural, Political and Religious systems

(a) Rasakan :- It was the exists a very beautiful story which shows the carelessness of the present governments towards rural areas and the old existing systems like local than and religious practices.

K. studies :- These studies all were pointing towards the development of the poor people. Poor people are today exploited and cheated every where by some

labour, child labour. Since they are ignorant about themselves, they can't get rid from all these deceptions. Only thing we can do is that to make them aware of their ignorance and liberate them.

Island:- In this beautiful story all the families came from the same parents but situation made them to separate each other so they forget their past and lived a luxurious life. But still there are people to help others. Here also economic problem is important.
 totally we can say each system are interconnected.
6. In this skit each person is trying to help the person in his misery. But no body is digging the root cause so he remains in the same situation. But all the development workers helped him to liberate himself.

① Community: Community is a group of people live together, following one rule together with a common leader. It is not mere an organisation but an organism. Its aim, orientation or purpose should be depend upon the particular group or community. Community itself is not an end but it is a means to attain a goal or a purpose, each community or group have its own uniqueness or Oneness. For the smooth running of the community among the team members there should be more or less same ideas or opinions. It is possible only through understanding and acceptance.

Health: As a whole health comprises of physical, mental and social health. Our body should work together to give physical health. Our mind must act harmoniously to give us mental health. We must enjoy being with other people that is social health.

Development: For this there should be a group to promote people to this kind and great art such as C. H. C. Development is an initiation towards progress, to looking about the reality within the community.

② ~~Health~~ Community health means the health of everyone in it. It is on the basis conscience of the government. All must work together to keep up the health of the people. And finally it is duty of the health services.

③ Healing is possible only when a person begins to feel that he wants to be healed. Jesus was going to the people and he healed the sick people such as leper, dumb, lame and so on. This was possible due to their faith, openness and their willingness to experience him. They were eager to be healed. They were ready to listen

to the words of Jesus. And also from the various Bible quotation we understand people were requesting Jesus to heal them. After healing them Jesus used to say: 'Go in peace, your faith made you well' and so on.

(4) Political, socio-cultural, economical and religion are the main four factors that constituted our community.

Protection, trade, industry, transportation, communication, education, occupation and government are the other main factors that are in our country.

(5) There are four main causes I realized from the various shows and case studies.

- ① India is not a problem but a country.
- ② Economical, socio-cultural, Political and Religion are intermingled.
- ③ Economical system is the basis for the rest of the system.
- ④ Our society is a ~~set~~ stratified society
ex: Power, prestige and possession.

These are the four main causes and systems that destroy our society especially those belonged to the 'lower lower class' people. They are exploited, deprived of their human rights and dignity by these systems. Nowhere their voice is considered and is taken into account since they are being poor and helpless.

Further our society is divided into different classes: upper upper class, ~~upper~~ lower ^{upper} class; upper middle class, lower middle class; upper lower class and lower lower class. These class systems become as a barrier from mingling and uniting each other since distribution of the Money, power (honour, prestige) and land are not equally divided thus the upper upper class become richer and richer and the same time

the lower lower class becomes poor and poor and they remain in the same situation all the time.

Thirdly in our society we have the 'Varna' system where again our society is divided into many categories.

(6) The vast majority of Indian masses are struggling with their problems - problems based on the existing socio-economic systems. Government and other agencies are trying to help them. But workers (ordinary people) are too enslaved to be liberated by their remedies. Most of them, except the animator - the symbolic figure of an ideal community health worker, fail to realize the basic problems. They misunderstood symptoms as disease. Their welfare and modernization approaches are not helping the victims. At last the critical analysis of animator (CH. worker) finds out the social system as real problem and provides a solution accordingly. At this state the sufferer makes use the chance to liberate himself from bondage.

This skit invites us, to join in the community health workers to deal with the social problems, not in a superficial manner, but in the grass root level. The total liberation is our aim.

- (7). (a) Even a single village community is a mixture of different communities - rich, poor, middle class families and untouchables
- (b) The villagers are depend on seasonal rain for their cultivation - rain is often irregular
- (c) Most of the villagers are not educated. They do not show great interest in cooperating with development workers and Banks.

- (d) Money lenders, though they charge huge interest, are a help to the ordinary villagers. But from his bitter experience from poor, his friends are only the rich but not the poor.
- (e) The rich are not ready to contribute and share to the lower lower classes of people.
- (f) Survival of an ordinary village is of a week.
- (g) Politicians are trying to fish in the troubled waters.
- (h) There is lack of cooperation among the villagers.
- (8) Community animator should analyse the existing system carefully. Through constant interaction with people he has to understand the merits and demerits of the present system. He has to accept the good elements and promote it. He has to take various initiative steps to find out the new methods and ideas for community. But these must come from the community. He ~~helps~~ helps them to work out their plan.

In short he acts only as an animator not as a commander-in-chief.

- (9) Now I find that, it is the need of the time to change the pattern of the social work. Now I cannot be mere a 'bread giver' or 'medicine supplier'. They are really 'floor mopping'. But my vocation is to be a 'step turner'. I must analyse the existing systems which are exploiting the poor. First of all I myself must be convinced of my role and as a second step I must convince my

own community. Thus I can effect a joint action for the betterment of the community.

In order to understand the situation better as a Franciscan Brother I must live with the people and undergo all their joys and pains sorrows.

(10) (a) Your mode of teaching and method of viewing at various problems and systems in India through skits, stories, monsoon game and slide shows are appreciable and these ways helped me to know them thoroughly and specifically.

(b) This course helped me to be critical in the process of study of society, systems, problems etc.

(c) This course helped me to get active participation from people and to organize them against these problems and systems.

(d) This course, indeed, is helpful for everyone who goes into the field of mission like members of the Franciscan missionary Brothers. Because they become top turners to every and each problem to easily tackle them after this course.

A community is made up of people who have similar customs and ways of looking at life and who think of themselves as belonging to that community. They live in a particular space that can be defined. A community has created laws or institutions to serve its people. A community has a common language or at least a system whereby its people can communicate with one another. A community will have certain problems that unite its people in a common cause. There are various types of community. Eg: A village community, contains of many smaller family, school and neighbourhood communities. It forms a part of many larger and larger communities linked to them by common interests. The local community, the metropolitan community, the national community, International community. In all this communities we can find unified (fixed) actions, agreement and disagreements and it is controlled by love. We see human oriented organizations. It is a group where each one is accepted, listened and appreciated not by an immediate family, by all fellow-men. A community lives for its growth and spreads out for the growth of others.

Health:-

Health means much more than not being sick but it gives a feeling of great, of good spirit. It helps us to be happier and do better work, to enjoy

play, sports and also to make friendship. Health as a whole includes physical, mental and social. according to the classes healing means = mentally spiritual healing - healing may be said as restoration. according to bible for healing Jesus demands faith. so it may be healing from bad habits, free from any thing bad, save, cleanse = Jesus told the blind man to wash his eyes. so it may be cleansing from sins; or get off rid of anything bad. But as in Christianity healing is presented as a salvation. Saving from sins. healing was miracle. Some say it was spiritual healing from bondage at sin, selfishness, anger, etc.

Holiness According to me it is a good attitude of a man towards his fellow men and women. Jesus showed his holiness by loving, forgiving, helping to poor, and needy. So I feel that holiness means The good deed of a man to his fellow men, by deeds and word, working for them, loving them, ~~struggling~~ struggling with them for their rights even to die for them.

But some say holiness means attaining perfection, not doing any wrong against God (Confessions and) to our neighbour.

Some say holiness means humility. It means free from sins, morally, materially holy.

5. From the slides we can understand the various systems which is still existing in India.

(1) Caste System: many are ~~separ~~ considered as low human beings. ~~for them~~, we are not providing education, medical facilities etc. Ex. Harijans they are considered as low cast they are not educated and they are deprived at many facilities.

(2) Ignorance: many are ignorant about the situation in which they are living, ignorance at social, political and Economic system. Ignorance at belief superstitions, ignorance to cultivate, ignorance at the development (in the 8th).

(3) Rich and Poor The two sides at India we see one side people enjoy, having all facilities, having Hospitals, school, Education centers, support from Govt. Having more lands, having many stories at Building. Govt. going on building schools, Hospitals but the same time in the villages no schools, no big hospitals no help from Govt and any department. Some time ~~but~~ people live in the huts, side at drainages, roads, etc. They don't have support from Govt. They are deprived at many things and facilities, they are suppressed and oppressed by Govt and by the rich people.

(4) Land lord system, Religious systems, Having division in religions, fighting in the name of God. Political and Economical system also a cause for the poverty in India. The leaders at that place when they become MLA they occupy the lands at the poor, to build factories, found for other uses. The Govt not Economically provides the things which is belong to the poor. Not equal distribution, may be lands, money any thing. Govt not feasible to cultivate the land which is given to them.

① Caste System - ② political system, ③ Economic System, ④ cultural system.

Economic Rich and Poor.

Political = Rich are always supported they have no right to ask anything.

Cultural : Karma theory, sins at our parents we are suffering, last birth you might have committed sin that is why you are suffering. Belief in fate that we are branded to suffer suffering as God's will, superstition also included.

The Skit

from the skit I have learnt many things that skit opened my mind not to be satisfied with mere piety, prayers, novices, but to do something to the living reality, go out from our culture structure, to help others in a useful way.

① The priest and pujari approaches the man who was bounded by structures, oppression poverty, suppression, ignorance, injustice, etc are bound the man not to get away and work. But he was not healthy because of the poverty, and the poor food. In that situation the pujari and c-priest approaches in a magical way saying = it is your sin that you are suffering or last birth you might have committed sin, another side priest gives him a Rosary to go recite. So the ~~prayer~~ and Rosary is not solution for his bondage. The ~~giver~~ the Doctor, Scientist, Health worker, A volunteer approaches him in a professional level, seeds to cultivate, prescription of medicine, chart book, soap and eatable things are ~~not~~ ^{will} not give solution to the man who was bounded by social ["]justice, society, politically, mentally. But the Animator plays a great role seeing the man bounded by many things, he gives instruments to break the bondage by himself by providing sickle, knife. It is a social justice approach. the sickle, knife gives him Education that the thing will not help but he has to cut the robe and fight for Justice.

So Animator finds out the Root cause and provides him the knowledge to come out of his bondage. We too should find out the root cause instead of giving mere solutions leading them to true liberation.

(7) What you learn from monsoon play.

In that play I found high class people, middle class people, low class people. Some could manage their day today life, by the cultivation income. But some to middle class. Even though these were rain problems, cattle problem, manure problem still the rich people could manage and save the money. But the Hindus or the poor class people had less land, less income, they were deprived at many things. The rich ~~class~~ was supported by Govt. all facilities were given to the rich class. But the money lenders, ~~managers~~, all were cheating ~~poor~~ ^{only the rich}.

~~But~~ The poor people were not getting which is given to the poor. So the village life shows the cast system, the poverty, poverty, and the deprivation at the things, such as Education, money, things etc. monsoon play shows even today the government support only the rich, ~~Govt~~ not bothered about the betterment of the poor.

(8) What is the role of the community animator.

The animator plays a great role in the community. When we want form a community the community looks at animator and it forms their character. The animator should be a mature man to decide what is good and wrong. - He should be a able person to lead and guide the community in a proper way by his own exemplary life. - He should work for the betterment of the community in a just way. He should have the knowledge of Political, Economical, and the changing systems of our country. He should work for the poor and needy. He should not be a self-centered man.

He should work justly for the good of the people and should promote justice, peace, harmony, fraternal love through his preaching and by deeds. He should be a balanced person mentally, physically, psychologically.

All the classes which was taken by all the Doctors were unforgettable and inspiring classes. I was not aware at many things which happens in India and H. ~~was~~ around me. all talkers and gildes were the key to many things. The monsoon play, The two faces of India, Healing, community and its sole, village life and its situations etc. all were explained clearly by the teachers.

= I came to know about the systems which are existing in India, and how it causes to suffering in the life of the people.

Economic and political ~~were~~ were good and useful. The classes helped me to think more about the suffering people, the poor, Oppressed all are created to share the good. Through an appropriate slide show he had succeeded in explaining various types of cultivation and the problems of poor farmers. The role of women was well shown in the slides, such as: caring the children, look after the family, work same as men in the fields etc...

From preparing the soil till harvesting, even after harvesting the farmers remain restless. Concerning skin diseases we came to know that, lack of knowledge about the effect of chemicals and pesticides. E.g.- manuring bare handed, long stay in muddy water bare footed etc...

9-6-1988 - (9.30 AM - 12.30 P.M. By Dr. Thelma)

The class lasted 3 hours, main discussions opened with sharing of the brothers about common diseases and their experiences, especially of the Thakorey and Bhandae.

She explained a lot about Leprosy, T.B., Typhoid, Gondrie, diarrhoea, Cholera etc...

Finally she concluded with a topic "what do people do when they are sick"? mainly this question touched the rural areas.

Concerning the rural people prayer and faith have a lot to do in healing.

She added that when we treat, see that they are treated a bit based on their own culture and customs.



He said the moderator and reporter must be two different persons, why? The reason is, if it is one person we will be able to use only half time. The leader should read out the guide lines and the group should modify within the time, whether the time is enough or not.

In any group discussion we can see one or two dominating and some will be quiet, it is the duty of the leader to pull out their knowledge.

Why they dominate? : confidence and over confidence.
speaking ability, knowledge, experience, eagerness.

When there is domination others freedom is cut. The duty leader is to see to this.

Why silence? : lack of confidence, fear complex, less knowledge, not interested, not open, fear of judgement, lack of language problem.



REPORT OF RAINSEASON GAME

The session was begun at 2.35 p.m on 8th June 1988, under the direction of Dr. Ravi and Mr. Gopi. We were divided into nine groups, these groups were known as Families in the village. Besides, there were a money lender and his Gurda, a news reporter and a village development worker.

Families A, B, C, D (middle class) got 5 fields each and E, F (Harijans) got three fields, 'E' family got 7 fields, 'G' 8 fields, and 'I' family occupied 10 fields (upper class).

The cultivation of this village was completely depended upon monsoon. The main crops were Ragi, Maize and Ground-nuts. Since they were depended on monsoon sometimes the fields production were good, average and poor. Then there were poor monsoons, those who got less fields couldnt adjust their needs. So they were mildly and severely malnourished, as well as they were affected with different kinds of disease. This situation made them to take money from the money lender and loan from the Bank. Since they were poor they couldnt repay money, as consequence, they lost their land, utter poverty, various disease and even some were migrated.

The news reporter also was the side of rich. The village development worker went on everywhere but the people especially the rich were not co-operative. Eventhough they assembled many times, lack of co-operation like building a Fund etc... were rejected.

The end of this game we understood that the rich became richer and the poor became poorer. The life of villagers exactly came in our game. It was most interesting, even the upperclass family didnt have much contact with Harijan families.

We clearly understood through this game various aspects of village life. The needs and convenience of villagers are the lowest of nation. Their problems are not yet solved. They are disunited among themselves like castorivalaries, lack of sharing etc... The villagers are mostly illiterate and ignorant. Therefore, anybody can express them in every sphere of their lives. So to say, we got an idea of a village and their problems. So it will help us in our future apostolate.

And also there are who speak more than also can be affect others, that also should be moderated by the leader. Above all, he has to clearly read out the matter which is going to discuss.

The task of secretary is, the suggestions and proposals are to be written within the time. After being collected all the opinions and informations of each members of the group, he should read out the summary among the members.

The members of the group should be seek information and act responsibly with regard to matters. Each member should take part actively forming their opinions and perform their duty well.

There is no reason of discouraging anybody due to the disagreement of opinions. The colleagues have the seriousness of the matter and act according to that, such a awareness help to produce much fruits.

In the following, I would like to draw certain points for a better procedure in a meeting or discussion. It is always good to begin with a small prayer in which we invoke God's assistance for making balanced decision. In a meeting like this there should be a leader who will be nominated, volunteered, elected or selected etc. The leader has an important role to play in the meeting. He or she may be called Leader, Chair person, Chairman, Moderator or facilitator.

Then comes the reporter or Secretary who will be noting the opinions of the members.

Next procedure is that it is the duty of the leader to introduce the task till everyone gets the idea about the subject. At this time full information should be communicated to the members of the discussion.

Now let us come to the participation. Every member is suppose to speak and communicate the ideas to the discussion. At the same time we should remember that we should not dominate the other members. Dominating means not only over speaking but also silent, disinterest and Glaublich etc. Now here is the duty of the Leader to seek their opinions in a friendly way. Common reasons for dominating are confidence or over confidence, speaking ability, knowledge / experience. These are good but if it is ^{so much} ~~so much~~ that will

effect the other member, then it is dominating.
Domination comes out of Aggression and pride.
Following are the reason if the other member kept
silence: lack of confidence, fear complex, less
knowledge about the matter, not interested, or not
free with in the group.

Communication has primarily
place in discussion. Communication means expressing
my ideas to the other one to understand me that
what I was trying to express. Then there comes
the importance of listening.

It is always good at the end
of the discussion the Secretary may read out
the opinions noted during the discussion and
ask for the clarifications. If there is any opposition,
the matter should be accepted in majority.

As we have began with a
prayer, it is advisable the concluding procedure
may be with a prayer.

- (2) It is the duty of Leader to present the matter to the community
- (3) Giving information and seeking information
- (4) Giving opinion and seeking opinion
- (5) moderate the group, that means those who are dominant & should be controlled and one who is silent also should be encouraged.
- (6) If there is any doubt should be clarified within the group.
- (7) After seeking all the opinions, the ideas should be summarized.

Participation means pooling the ideas of the group. It is the duty of everybody to participate in it. i.e. one's own mind and whole attention should be given to the group. Listen to each other is very important for the participation.

The word Participation brings many meanings. Participation signifies the derivation of temporal divinity from external unity, and the structural dependence of the many on the one.

In ordinary usage, the word signifies a sharing or taking part in the word a common effort, glory, nature, or moment thus every order of causality one may share or take part in some whole part or take. It signifies the act of giving or communicating something to others.

Ordinarily speaking ~~as many~~ it is used in the intrinsic sense of a subject, having a part, or taking part in same reality, physically, morally.

Participation, here means, that a group of people involving as communicating a community physically and emotionally. In a group there will be the leader, who right to give a portion to discuss, and he should be the leader to that session. In order to run the group discussion smoothly, a systematic arrangement is essential.

- (1) A Leader as well as a moderator. (Selection by group members)
- (2) A Secretary
- (3) Facilitators who have to contribute ideas
- (4) A democracy unit need
- (5) Everybody should take enough participation
- (6) And Finally the Secretary will read out the matter in which we all participated.
- (7) Leader should take the initiative if each and every member should contributing or not.

We can't sure, that all the members may able to share their ideas, but in that case, the leader must encourage them. During the session, if anybody will walk out, the group discussion must be continued without breaking its session.

Reporter

His duty whatever happens in the meeting (group discussion) he has to write down make a proper report about the discussion. Finally he has to read out what he is written in the same group and get upto approve from the group other members.

It is their duty to contributing the idea about the subject. They must be co-operative with chairman. If we have any idea courageously have say. If it is wrong or correct. The success of the discussion depends upon the group members.

In any group discussion there must be a chairman and reporter. The duty of the chairman to lead the discussion and he has to see all must participate the discussion. And all must get equal chance. If there is a big meeting it is required a time keeper also. It is the duty of the participant to take active part in the meeting. In any meeting we can see some will quiet. Some will be over dominate. The chairman has to see this. One who is not talking he has to encourage him to take part.

Lack of confidence, fear complex, less knowledge, not interest in the subject not free with group, judgment etc. why some are dominating? over confidence speaking ability, knowledge experience, enthusiasm etc. The group discussion will help us to understand improve our participation. Task of the leader

His main duty to preside over the meeting. First he has to introduce the theme purpose and what we have to do. Then he has to give information to the participant. Then he has to ask the ^{opinion} of others and finally he has to contribute his ideas.

Procedure of a meeting as follows:

First and for most the group must elect a ~~to~~ moderator after the election. They have to elect a reporter. Now we shall come to the meeting, it is good to start with a prayer. ## Participation in dialogue

There are many matters in a dialogue. In order to participate worthily we should know some of the important matters.

First of all there should be a leader.

Secondly there should be a reporter.

The leader's duty is to lead the dialogue and the reporter should write the decisions ~~which~~ ~~not~~ that are taken.

Now there are some duties concerning leader. Before beginning the programme the leader describes or reads the particular matter which is to be discussed.

After making aware of the matter to the community starts the discussion.

Now each one brings out his own or person's ideas. Other wise the leader or one who gets an idea presents it to the community and ask the question: What you say ~~about it~~ about it? ## Participation in a Group

Participation means to take part actively, in other words to involve fully, that is physically and emotionally.

In a group there should be a leader. His duty is that, to see all the members of that group is getting involve otherwise he must ask the member to share his idea.

Finally there should be a reporter he should take down all that is discussed. Leader's duty is to give time for all, when he sees that someone is not giving idea, he should ask the person in a friendly manner and encourage him. This makes a full friendship between each other.

There should be giving information and seeking or opinion giving and seeking. This also makes a true community. Then all the ideas should be classified within that group. For this leader should co-ordinate.

Communication is very important because through communication only we can understand each other. In this we can express idea but do not try to express the person.

Introducing the theme is very important. Then only we can classify it at the end of that make a summary of all that held before. For this group discussion very important thing is to listen each other.

Participation is that one who takes part in assembly or in gatherings groups first and for most we select a moderator or leader and reporter. ~~Even~~ Very often in discussion ~~that~~ shall we forget to elect a leader or Moderator. The leader should see every body gets chance to share the matter, bring right judgment and decision or solution.

Those who are keeping silent make them to open and when subject put forth we should try to discuss the matter we never go out of the subject beyond this. when one goes out of the matter try him in quitting very back to our subject. when ever we ~~participate~~ have gathering for the discussion participate with full enthusiasm and self awareness is very very important. when we communicate such matters call a person in name it gives more impression relationship to one another.

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## PARTICIPATION

In the group discussion, first of all we must choose a leader (chairperson) and a reporter. Then the leader or one of the group members will read out or say the matters for discussion. We must see that whether we can come to a conclusion within the given time.

The duty of the leader is to control the group members, especially ~~a go~~<sup>those who</sup> out of the matter and do not mind others opinion. The reporter has to write down the suggestions and opinions, that are brought forth by others and by himself.

In the discussion, every body must get a chance to bring out their ideas about the matter. In the discussion, if one person's opinion is not so appealing to me, I must not jump over him immediately, instead speak in a polite way that he may not be offended. Speak one at a time.

During the discussion, if one keeps silence the leader should encourage him to speak his opinion about the matter. It is better for the guideline to call out every person by ~~man~~ name and to seek the opinion.

we must be very carefull that not to hurt others.

## Participation -

To participate simply means to take part in a function or a group discussion. But if we go deeper and deeper into this word it is beyond a mere participation or our presence in a group. Here we discover one's whole person, his mind, body, his attention towards the group. He listens to the discussions and deliberations and gives his opinion / viewpoint to the matter which is being discussed. He does not flatter neither go away from the real matter.

Again participation would mean - giving up of oneself totally to a group. Feeling that the matter in discussion is - pertains to him and he has to give / bound to give his opinion to the group for the successful execution. Merely bodily presence in a committee does not make participation. It is the duty of every participant to see that the discussions are not gone away from the real matter. And <sup>there is</sup> any silent-participant is in a group it is the duty of the other participants to give him a chance to express in this particular topic. Thus the whole programme will be in active participation by all members. And also every participant has the right to express his feelings, visions, his support and rejection of other opinions. If it does not seem to be appropriate. Thus participation means one's full involvement into a group and opening himself to that particular group and receiving all the information. Thus participation has two sides.

PARTICIPATION.

What is participation?

Participation is to involve a matter physically and emotionally (mentally) to take decision in the community. In other word take part or share in the community.

Context of participation in different situation:

In the community there will be nominators and listeners. S.I is the leader who should see these situation and manage the members. Allow all the members to take part in community. Leader or moderator should call each one's name and ask them to give opinion. Leader should ask in friendly manner not by forcing them.

This system gives relationship between leader and other members. This is called democracy situation.

The full participation means, information giving and seeking and opinion giving and seeking and also some clarification. It is the leader's task, not only information giving but he has to take opinion from the other members. Point should be discussed in the meeting not to go out of point. In this case leader has to work as a Co-ordinator. Leader has to encourage the members to express their feeling in useful way. It is called friendly manner expression (Democratic System).

Communication is to understand others. There are various communications in this modern world. But this communication is different from them. This communication is to exam the idea not exam the person. To give equal share to each member to express their feeling and clarification. This is a real communication.

Within the Community facilities communication also should take part. S.I is to receive from the other members we have to listen. Above is said, these all the aspects should take participation in the community.

PARTICIPATION.

Participation plays very important role in any group discussion. Any discussion is more fruitful when all the members participate actively and fully in the discussion. According to me participation is to take part or to involve ourselves actively in the particular task to be discussed or fulfilled. For any group discussion the prime duty is to select or elect or nominate a facilitator or moderator who will moderate the discussion. The next work we have to do in the group discussion is to elect a reporter who will take the minutes of the dialogue. The important role of the facilitator is to control the dominator and to pull out the silent one. The facilitator should give confidence to the silent one and he should make all the members to share their opinions and views with regard to the task. Participation doesn't mean to be present in a discussion but involving emotionally and physically.

First of all leader has to introduce the theme to the group and he has to seek information and afterwards he can give information also. Then his task is to seek opinion from others and he can give opinion also. I strongly feel participation doesn't mean only speaking or giving opinions, ideas, views but to the greater extent it also involves listening. When one shares or gives his opinion all the other members should listen to that particular member's view whether it is

correct or not then only participation will be full. One should not let down other members of the group.

We can say one is physically healthy only when all the organs of his body functions well like wise any discussion will be fruitful only when all its members participate fully and actively in the discussion and share their views, opinions and ideas and patiently listening to the opinions of others and pulling out the silent members of the group saying him that his ideas or views also important and controlling the dominating one.



GROUP DISCUSSIONS AND MEETINGS  
(Training paper III)

Every meeting and discussion has its own dynamics. However there are certain conditions or behaviour which will help a group to function effectively and to complete its task. There are also conditions and behaviour which will hinder the group. These can be related either to the group's task, or to the process of the discussion.

The following contribute to a good discussion:

A. Related to the task

1. Members take the initiative to define the task, define words and concepts, clarify issues, introduce new ideas, etc.
2. The task is clear to every member of the group, and all members accept it.
3. Members have the information they need; or they seek it from each other.
4. Members freely give information and facts related to the task, and also offer their opinions.
5. Members speak from their personal experience, giving specific examples.
6. Members listen to each other's contributions, and ask for clarifications from each other of what is not clear.
7. The focus remains on the central issues.
8. There is a periodic summary, a putting together of ideas, or the testing of a conclusion.
9. Any conclusion is tested against reality to see if it 'fits'.

B. Related to the process

1. Members agree on a procedure for the discussion.
2. There is a periodic evaluation of the progress of the discussion.
3. The climate in the group encourages everyone to participate.
4. People listen, not only to the words spoken, but also to the feelings behind the words, and to the non-verbal expressions.
5. There is a periodic expression of the feeling in the group.
6. Any tensions which arise within the group are reduced or believed.
7. Arguments are reconciled, differences are explored, members 'agree to disagree agreeably'.
8. There is a periodic testing for consensus or decisions.

The following hinder a good discussion:

A Related to the task

1. Lack of clarity about-or commitment to-the group's task
2. Failure to give, or to seek, information which is available with group members.
3. Failure to stick to the main issues
4. Generalized agreements at a high level of abstraction.
5. Failure to check out and clarify exactly what is not clear when someone else speaks.
6. Excessive probing for another member's opinions or experience when he does not want to share these any further.
7. The introduction of irrelevant personal topics, anecdotes, interests.

B. Related to the process

1. No agreement on procedure.
2. A climate of tension, or of domination and control by one or two people.
3. Failure to listen to others.
4. Interrupting others while they are speaking.
5. Hurt feelings, and failure to deal with these and other group feelings.
6. Withdrawal of some members or displays of non-participation.
7. No review of the progress of the discussion.
8. Excessive disagreement and opposition for personal reasons.
9. Passing judgement on what others say; deflating others; or giving them advice.
10. Struggles for power, recognition or leadership
11. Formation of sub-groups.
12. Vested interests and 'hidden agendas'.

A person who is acting obstructively is probably doing so, not because of any intellectual difficulty, but because his feelings are upset.

If a member feels:

- a. that his role or identity in the group is not clear, or
- b. that the group's task is not worthwhile, or
- c. that he should be wielding more influence than he is, or
- d. that the group does not like or accept him.

then he may behave obstructively. Sensitivity to this point can help the members of a group to see more clearly what is happening in the group.

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## GROUP DISCUSSION: THE MODERATOR'S ROLE IN A DEMOCRATIC

### DISCUSSION GROUP

(Training paper IV)

#### Throughout the discussion

1. Make sure that everyone understands and accepts the task, the problem, or the issues which the group is going to discuss.
2. Help everyone to participate. Don't let one or two members monopolize the discussion.
3. Encourage the members to share the opinions, the information, the skills, and the other resources which they have and which are needed to complete the task.
4. When necessary, clarify what members say through questions or re-phrasing. Ask questions rather than give answers.
5. Encourage members to speak for themselves ('I think...') and from their personal experience, and to give specific examples. Discourage them from speaking very generally and making statements like, 'Some people seem to think...'
6. See that members listen to each other and seek clarifications from each other if necessary. Do not allow interruptions.
7. Keep the focus on the central task or issues.

#### From time to time

8. Make a summary from time to time. This may involve putting ideas together, reconciling arguments, exploring differences of opinion, and testing out conclusions for consensus. Don't hesitate to draw attention to differences of opinion.
9. Listen to the feelings being expressed behind the words spoken. Allow the group feeling to be expressed from time to time.
10. If there is a lot to discuss and the group is large, keep in mind the possibilities for breaking into smaller groups.
11. If you want to give your personal opinions, do so outside your role as moderator. Say, for example, 'Speaking personally, as Swamy, and not as moderator, I think...'.
12. Keep track of time. At the beginning of a discussion you may ask the members if they want to set time limits.
13. If the discussion becomes bogged down and people appear bored or tired, suggest a short break (or a game).
14. Ask the members to evaluate the progress of the discussion from time to time.

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## FEEDBACK

(Training paper V)

'Feedback' is information given to a person (or a group or an organization) about how he affects others. It helps him become more aware, both of his strengths and of his weaknesses. It does not tell him what he should do, but it raises questions for him. It helps him to decide whether to change his behaviour, so that he can be more effective and better able to achieve what he wants.

If feedback is given in a positive way it can be helpful. But if it is given wrongly, it is not only unhelpful, but can also be destructive. Here are some guidelines for giving feedback.

DO be specific. Give examples and data. For example, 'When you interrupted me just now I felt annoyed.' The other person is able to make use of such information if he chooses to do so.

DON'T make general statements, such as, 'I feel annoyed because you never listen to me.' Unless you can give some specific examples, the receiver may not understand or believe what you are telling him.

DO describe your own feelings and reactions. For example, 'I felt hurt'. This is what you actually known.

DON'T describe the other person's feelings or motives or intentions. For example, 'You wanted to hurt me.' You do not know this: it is only your guess or interpretation. Such feedback will probably be rejected.

DON'T judge the other person's actions. For example, 'You were wrong to shout at me.' Statements like this only produce a defensive reaction.

DON'T make general evaluative statements about the other person's character. For example, 'You are dominating and inconsiderate'. The person who is told this will probably react defensively.

DO think of the needs of the other person and of what will be useful to him. Feedback should be constructive.

DON'T speak only out of your own need to react or score on the other person: that is irresponsible and destructive.

DO speak only of behaviour which the other person could change, for example, his habit of interrupting. This is within his control.

DON'T speak of behaviour over which he has no control, for example, his habit of stammering. To comment on that will only increase his frustration.

DO choose the right time, climate and company to give feedback. Generally it is most useful immediately after the event concerned.

DON'T give feedback long after the event, in some other situation, with some other group of people.

DO give feedback when the other person asks for it. Better still, ask him exactly what he wants to know.

DON'T give feedback if the other person has made it clear that he does not want it.

DO encourage him to check with anyone else who was present about the accuracy of the feedback. This can be done in a group. Feedback is more effective if it is received from several sources.

DO ask the receiver if he understands what you are saying even though he may not accept it.

- : 2 : -

Feedback is a way of giving help. It is a corrective mechanism for the persons who wants to learn how well his behaviour matches his intentions. It is a means of increasing a person's autonomy and establishing his identity-for answering the question 'Who am I ?'.

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#### ELEMENTS OF TEAMWORK

There are a number of elements to teamwork. These are not easily achieved, but they are excellent targets as we work together in groups, committees, organizations and communities.

1. Teamwork requires an understanding of, and commitment to, the task and objectives of the group.
2. Teamwork requires the maximum utilization of the different resources of the individuals within the group.
3. Teamwork is achieved when flexibility, sensitivity to the needs of others, and creativity are encouraged.
4. Teamwork is most effective when leadership is shared.
5. Teamwork requires a group to develop appropriate procedures for meeting particular problems or situations, and for making decisions.
6. Teamwork is characterized by the group's ability to examine its own process, so as to constantly improve itself as a team.
7. Teamwork requires trust and openness in communication and relationships.
8. Teamwork is achieved when the group members have a strong sense of belonging.



Through the visual we could understand the two kinds of people live in India. One side people enjoy wealth, freedom, accumulating money and living but another side people starve because of food, lack of money at education.

Example: a rich old man uses the hair cream to blacken their grey hair but at the same time many aged abandoned old people are dying because of hunger, lack of good health and medicine.

One side: a girl goes to beauty parlour to change their fashion to appear well, some women change their clothes, treat with perfumes, to appear as a pretty woman or men. But the same time we see a naked mother with child even unable to cover her body, same time a pregnant woman gives birth to a dead child because no facility at all. These are the facts of India.


We also tried to define the causes of unhealthy communities such as Religion, language, worship, social, economic and political influences.



## Understanding Communities

### Checklist

#### 1) Understanding and describing a community:

Understanding the community entails understanding it in a number of ways. Whether or not the community is defined geographically, it still has a geographic context -- a setting that it exists in. Getting a clear sense of this setting may be key to a full understanding of it. At the same time, it's important to understand the specific community you're concerned with. You have to get to know its people -- their culture, their concerns, and relationships -- and to develop your own relationships with them as well.

- **Physical aspects.** Every community has a physical presence of some sort, even if only one building. Most have a geographic area or areas they are either defined by or attached to. It's important to know the community's size and the look and feel of its buildings, its topography (the lay of the land -- the hills, valleys, rivers, roads, and other features you'd find on a map), and each of its neighborhoods. Also important are how various areas of the community differ from one another, and whether your impression is one of clean, well-maintained houses and streets, or one of shabbiness, dirt, and neglect.

If the community is one defined by its population, then its physical properties are also defined by the population: where they live, where they gather, the places that are important to them. The characteristics of those places can tell you a great deal about the people who make up the community. Their self-image, many of their attitudes, and their aspirations are often reflected in the places where they choose -- or are forced by circumstance or discrimination -- to live, work, gather, and play.

- **Infrastructure.** Roads, bridges, transportation (local public transportation,) electricity, land line and mobile telephone service, broadband service, and similar "basics" make up the infrastructure of the community, without which it couldn't function.
- **Patterns of settlement.** Where are those physical spaces we've been discussing? Communities reveal their character by where and how they create living and working spaces. Where there are lower caste group residing; substandard housing in areas with few or no services that are the only options for low-socio economic background people.
- **Demographics.** It's vital to understand who makes up the community. Age, gender, caste and ethnicity, marital status, education, number of people in household, first language -- these and other statistics make up the demographic profile of the population.
- **History.** The long-term history of the community can tell you about community traditions, what the community is, or has been, proud of, and what residents would prefer not to talk about. Recent history can afford valuable information about conflicts and factions within the community, important issues, past and current relationships among key people and groups -- many of the factors that can trip up any effort before it starts if you don't know about and address them.

- **Community leaders, formal and informal.** Some community leaders are elected or appointed others are considered leaders because of their activities or their positions in the community.
- **Community culture, formal and informal.** This covers the spoken and unspoken rules and traditions by which the community lives. It can include everything from community events to norms of behavior - turning a blind eye to alcohol abuse or domestic violence - to patterns of discrimination and exercise of power. Understanding the culture and how it developed can be crucial, especially if that's what you're attempting to change.
- **Existing groups.** Most communities have an array of groups and organizations of different kinds such as youth organizations, sports teams and groups formed around shared interests, the boards of community-wide organizations well as groups devoted to self-help, advocacy, and activism. Knowing of the existence and importance of each of these groups can pave the way for alliances or for understanding opposition.
- **Existing institutions.** Every community has institutions that are important to it, and that have more or less credibility with residents. Educational institutions, libraries, religious institutions, hospitals -- all of these and many others can occupy important places in the community. It's important to know what they are, who represents them, and what influence they wield.
- **Economics.** Who are the major employers in the community? Are there any village based artisans? Who, exercises economic power? How is wealth distributed? Would you characterize the community as poor, working, class, middle class, or affluent? What are the economic prospects of the population in general and/or the population you're concerned with?
- **Government/Politics.** Understanding the structure of community government is obviously important. Some communities may have local self governance members, whatever the government structure, where does political power lie? Understanding where the real power is can be the difference between a successful effort and a vain one.
- **Social structure.** Many aspects of social structure are integrated into other areas social relationships, politics, economics-but there are also the questions of how people in the community relate to one another on a daily basis, how problems are (or aren't) resolved, who socializes or does business with whom, etc. This area also includes perceptions and symbols of status and respect, and whether status carries entitlement or responsibility (or both).
- **Attitudes and values.** Again, much of this area may be covered by investigation into others, particularly culture. What does the community care about, and what does it ignore? What are residents' assumptions about the proper way to behave, to dress, to do business, to treat others? Is there widely accepted discrimination against one or more groups by the majority or by those in power? What are the norms for interaction among those who with different opinions or different backgrounds?

Is there anything people do to take care of their health? If yes, what?  
 When do people seek help for a health concern?  
 Where to people seek help for their illness, and why?

**d. Basic Amenities**

Housing, water, sanitation, transport, recreation

**e. Others if any**

When you have all the information gathered in that you can use, line up the expressed needs and work out your priorities.

Prevalence: is the need widespread?

Severity: is the need serious or only a minor inconvenience?

Selectivity: is it expressed most by a particular segment of the community?

Possible interventions: Some needs are going to be very real but out of your reach; you will have to pick out the needs that your organisation is capable of addressing.

**3. Understanding the field placement organisation and their projects:**

We at SOCHARA inform you confidently that you have been placed in a very interesting and innovative project which is committed to health and development of their project areas. While there is a lot to learn from the community, there is a lot to learn from your field placement organisation. Each of you will have unique experiences as each organisation is different. When you understand about the organisation's vision, mission, objectives and structure, you will have a better idea about what you can expect to additionally learn from them during your placement with them. Without understanding the organisation well enough, you may miss opportunities or have unreasonable expectations from them.

Therefore, to best utilise your field placement, we recommend that you also understand the organisation, its principles and its functioning, besides understanding the local community. It is the project staff that will facilitate your interaction (at least initially) with the community, and it would be useful that you learn about their past and ongoing activities there before you step out into the community.

Here are some guidelines to help you explore about the project based on which you are expected to prepare a short report and presentation about the project. Based on your presentation, the other CHLP fellows too can learn about your field organisation. It is important to note that this should not be conducted like an interview! Also this is not just a writing assignment, but rather an opportunity to improve your own understanding about the organisation, to help you plan your health promotion and research projects for terms 2/3. Consider enquiring about:

- Organisational vision, philosophy of work, and organisational objectives
- Number of staff and system structure – role of each staff position
- Geographical distribution of project areas (preferably with map)
- Current projects
  - Objective of each project
  - Activities under each project – describe them
  - List out the various stakeholders of the projects – and their roles (with organogram)
  - Community involvement in the project (with a flow diagram showing linkages)
  - Process and outcome monitoring protocols used by them
  - Source of funding
- Their previous experience with fellows/interns and training programmes

To find out about the above themes, we suggest that you:

- read organisational reports and brochures – if possible, before you go there (from their website or from SOCHARA library)
- speak with your field mentor and with community based staff and get their inputs during the first week of your stay there – learn about their role and experience there
- attend their team meetings when permissible, and observe (and take notes)
- participate in field activities and trainings as an observer and as an assistant
- copy or create a project area map

Remember that your role is to understand the organisation and its functioning, and not to critique it. Every organisation is faced with several challenges, about which you can discuss with your SOCHARA mentor either over phone or when you return to Bangalore in April.

#### 4. Social determinants of health and Inter-sectoral collaboration:

The social determinants of health are the conditions in which the people are born, grow, live, work and age, including the health system.

1. What are the major health problems of the community based on yours observation? Whether the hospitals in the community alone can address those health problems? If not, what is your opinion?
2. Are there any social hierarchy/ social position existing in the community? If yes, what are forms in which it is existing? (eg- Socio-economic hierarchy consists of rich at the top, followed by Upper middle class, lower middle class and poor at the bottom)
3. During your field work, could you observe any health inequity in that community? What are they?
4. Does a person being a male or female have something to do with his/her health condition? Could you think of it with an example of a disease?
5. Is the social hierarchy/ social position in the community has something to do with the health inequity of that community? If yes, how? Could you think of it with an example of a disease?
6. What are all the living conditions' that need to be improved to attain the health equity of that community?
7. Could you think of some redistribution mechanism to achieve health equity for that community? Also, what need to be redistributed?
8. Whom do you think needs to work to address the social determinants of health? Also, at what levels? (International, local?)
9. Do you see a need for Inter-sectoral collaboration at all levels to ensure the social determinants are met for that community?
10. What are the sectors that need to collaborate at national, state and local levels to bring health equity for that community?



- b) Local healers – these could be herbalists or they may focus on some problems like snake bite, bone setting etc. Often they are associated with temples and religious places since local healing is often linked to rituals.
  - c) Practitioners of alternative systems of Medicine in India. We have five major systems- Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy. In different parts of India different systems are popular.
  - d) Practitioners of Allopathy or what is also sometimes called ‘English Medicine’ modern system of medicine. In this category you may have
    - General Practitioners; ii) Ngo’s centres or mission hospitals and dispensaries;
    - Government health centres and dispensaries with doctors and nurses;
    - Private health centres and dispensaries or nursing homes; v) there may be some others not listed above.
3. You can walk around the village or slum or adivasi community and find these services. You can also sit with small groups of people in the community or health workers, Panchayat leaders, teachers, self help groups, youth groups, and discuss the following:  
-What do people do when they fall ill? ; -Whom do they go to? ; - For what?; - What do they feel about this services or practitioners ; - Any other information.
  4. If possible meet some of these health care providers and spend a little time in their setting to know about their work.
  5. In every community people also practice some local health traditions and use their own home remedies including home remedies and local health practices. Sit with a small group of local women. (Women are usually custodians of local health knowledge) and ask them what they do at home level if they or some member of the family falls ill. These practices are often called home remedies, ‘grandmother’ remedies, or local health traditions.
  6. Another way to find out more about these different options and services is to ask a group of people  
What do they do? And whom do they go to? - When they have the following health problems individually or at family level:
    - a) Fever; b) Diarrhoea ; c) Snake Bite; d) For delivery ( Child Birth); e) If someone is mentally unwell; f) If someone has fits ( Epilepsy); g) Joint Pains
7. Talk to the medical officer of the government health centre and or ANMS and or Anganwadi workers and or ASHA’s - when you are studying PHC and NRHM and also ask them about the local health traditions and health practitioners of other systems of health care in the community. What is their opinion about them?
  8. Write a short report on all the various options available to the people in the community. This is Medical Pluralism. We shall discuss further details and frame work of how AYUSH systems and local health traditions can become part of the public health system.
