The campus has a unique landscaping consisting of 600 medicinal plants. It also has a medicinal plant nursery, where one can pick-up medicinal plants to grow at home or office. This 20-bed hospital has 8 specious double rooms including 2 deluxe rooms with AC and other facilities.

FRLHT has a team of 15 Ayurvedic doctors and Siddha, Unani and Yoga Consultants. The clinical team consists of 5 doctors headed by a postgraduate in General Medicine with 15 years of clinical experience. In-house canteen provides excellent Indian vegetarian foods of balancing nature cooked as per the advise of the physicians. All the Panchakarma treatment prescribed in Ayurveda and also other special Kerala treatments of purification are conducted here.

Health or swasthya is therefore defined by Ayurveda as a perfect state of equilibrium, of body &mind.
