




## BPNI

- We work in advocacy, training, monitoring of the IMS Act, social mobilization, maternity protection and others.


## Current Status NFHS-2 1999 data

- ICDS III, National Nutrition Mission, RCH II
- National guidelines on IYCF
- Implementation of the IMS Act 1992 / Amendment 2003
- **ICDS III : Approx. 12 Lac women ICDS workers AWS / AHS need**
- **They need skilled inputs**

- **Initiatives**
  - GOI-BPNI-UNICEF National Planning Workshop and 5 Regional Workshops on IYCF: 2002-2003
  - National guidelines on IYCF( to be released soon)
  - IMS Act 1992 and Amendment Act 2003.

## Action Recommendations

- Organize State level consultations to develop state plan of Action on IYCF (like e.g. M.P. has done already)
- Capacity building : training of trainers on IYCF counseling (including breastfeeding, complementary feeding and HIV infant feeding) at state level training centers(ICDS and RCH).
- Request to Chair a meeting of concerned national partners to develop this action plan. (Nov. 2001 a meeting was chaired by the JS and Director HIPCDD and a Draft Plan of Action on IYCF evolved)
- *EPIC is more than willing to assist and has the required mandate and capacity.*
